Method of teaching and it's benefits-

The teaching method of Pali workshop will be with the drilling method in which every single word will be explored and derived grammatically. Only grammar will be focused, so that the student can learn the language soon. There will be two ways of teaching these subjects - one through the grammar directly (Kaccayana Vyakarana for Pali), of course, in precise way, and the other through the texts of the subject. The sentences of Pali will be rendered into Sanskrit first and translated into Hindi or English and then grammatical analysis, phonetical changes, derivation of verbal forms, participles, syntax, compound, contraction, indeclinable etc. will be clearly explained to the satisfaction of every participant. This method has been very successful. This was the method that elevated the level of workshop scholarly world was obliged to take it seriously. And now it is noticed and known worldwide.

This is a non-conventional method of teaching the classical language generally applied in western world. It will enable the students to be self-reliant. It will make the students capable in analyzing the words, parsing the sentences, identifying the grammatical varieties of words properly. This will enable the students to be equipped with the capacity to edit, translate and criticize the scriptures on his/her own.
